#### INFO ON ADAM

Just an update from last issue, no, COLECO is not releasing the 1200 BAUD modem. We found this out approximately three days after press date.

There has been many changes on the latest (and probably last) production of ADAM. The latest printer has an improved paper holding device, which is better shaped; a vastly improved printer, so there is less noise. Many other changes include the DATAPACK DRIVE. There is now a metallic clip holding the datapack in place. Even the eject switch on the datapack drive has been changed a few times. And probably the most important change on the ADAM is the price. You can buy an ADAM now for less than a good printer, \$299.

We've been recieving letters from people complaining about COLECO's helpline. The only thing we have to say is that COLECO has only five or six operators on duty. Disabling CNTRL C:

There are two ways for disabling CNTRL C.

1 ONERR GOTO 10000

2 REM PROGRAM GOES HERE:

10000 IF ERRNUM<>255 THEN RESUME: REM If there's an error other than a BREAK ERROR

10010 CALL 64743: REM This will return you to the word processor

OR:

1 ONERR GOTO 10000

2 REM PROGRAM GOES HERE

10000 NOBREAK : RESUME : REM RESUME WHERE YOU LEFT OFF.

Using a RAM DRIVE in your BASIC programs:

Recently we were given information on a RAM DRIVE from one of our subscribers, MARK FULLMER. This so called RAM DRIVE is assigned to the D3 and D4 ports. (Both ports are

to one Ram Drive.) With this RAM DRIVE you'll be able to save a single program or file to memory. This is definately an advantage for quick loading and running of a frequently used program. The disadvantages to this is you can't save a program no more than around twenty linenumbers long and you can only save 1 program to memory. Not all has been learned about this yet, so we suggest saving the program to tape or disk before saving it to memory. This also may not work on all ADAM systems. And remember the "saved" file isn't permantly saved, it will be lossed after computer is reseted or turned off.

Smartwriter locks up while printing?

If your printer locks and hangs your file, try turning the carriage wheel manually. Sometimes this will release the printer and allow work to continue. If this fails the printer must go back to HONEYWELL. REMEMBER: ALWAYS SAVE YOUR WORK BEFORE PRINTING.

Info on CP/M BDOS Errors:

If you are tired of BDOS errors do the following:

1) Type this at the "A>" prompt: SAVE O CONT.COM Whenever you get a BDOS error all you have to do is type:

1) CONT.

This will jump to and execute any program currently in memory.
